DIGGING DEEPER

DISCUSSION/REFLECTION

1. What does the phrase, “Land Between” mean to you?
2. What kind of anxieties have come into your life because of trials and challenges? How often have you chosen to “complain about” these challenges? How many times have you chosen to trust God in it? How has that been working for you?
3. Read (Numbers 11:11-34) What do we learn about how Moses and the Israelites handled being stuck in the in-between? How do you see yourself in this story?
4. Has there been a time that you have not only complained about the situation you were in, but you turned to complain against God? How did that work for you? What was the end result? What were the lessons you learned?
5. Pastor Mark talked about how the land between can be a place where we see God's provision. How have you witnessed this to be true in your walk? How has it helped you in other seasons of waiting?
6. Pastor Mark also talked about those times where God disciplines us. Has there ever been a time where God has disciplined you? What did it look like? How long did it take for you to surrender? Have you surrendered yet? If not, what do you need to let go of and trust God in?
7. What steps can you take to allow God to provide the help you need to journey through the “Land Between?” How can you draw closer to God so that complaint will leave and trust will move in?
